P7 FAMILIARISATION AFTERNOON

KEY POINTS FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

1. Bring your child to front entrance of Bloomfield Collegiate School at 4.00 pm. Only candidates taking the tests will be permitted beyond the front doors of the main building which is the venue for the assessments.
2. Please note that although no car parking spaces are available on the school site, there are car parking spaces available in the surrounding area.
3. School uniform is optional; comfortable clothes are recommended but no sports tops please.
4. Children must bring the CEA Desk Card provided by AQE, two sharpened pencils and a rubber but no pencil case. They should also bring the seating plan card, already supplied.
5. Mobile phones, digital devices and food or drink (except for medical reasons) should not be brought into the test venue.
6. Parents are asked to accompany their children to the main building but not to enter or to linger outside.
7. The children will be shown to their desk by school staff and Bloomfield pupils.
8. During this session, Invigilators will explain the procedures for the test and the children will be given practice in filling in the first page of the test booklet (they will not be answering any test questions at this time). Arrangements for the use of toilets, evacuation procedures and how to ask for assistance during the tests will also be explained.
9. It is envisaged that this familiarisation session will be over at around 4.45 pm after which invigilators will accompany the children to the front of school to be reunited with parents.
